

## TATTERSALL'S CELLAR AUTUMN WINE SPECIALS



### **OAKRIDGE 864 'FUNDERS BLOCK CHARDONNAY 2011**

**\$65 per bottle**

Pale straw with bright green hues and complex from the outset. Burnt match, pink grapefruit, lime leaf and ginger lily's vie for attention. Light on its feet and angular, rather than broad and deep. Lime leaf, grapefruit, flint and minerals followed by brioche and lemongrass sitting over a crystalline citrus acidity.



### **TELMO RODRIGUEZ 'PAGO LA JARA' TEMPRANILLO 2009**

**\$89 per bottle**

Electric and soft, the red and blue nose has brambly fruit, tree berries and blueberry skins edged by anise and graphite, with a puff of ripe fruit tannin smells. In the mouth, nicely spiced and silky round fruits are shaped by slick, siltily-earthen fruit tannins and cut with a nice vegetal (fennel and peppermint herb) tweak.



### **CRAWFORD RIVER RIESLING 2005 MUSEUM RELEASE**

**\$69 per bottle**

Steely minerality and intense aromas of sweet limes pervade the lifted nose, with white stone fruit, nuances and spice. The integrated, seamless palate displays a layered complexity with luscious baked quince and white peach dancing in tune with stoney nuances and fine, linear acidity.



### **DOMAINE LUCCI (LUCY MARGAUX VINEYARDS) 'LITTLE CREEK' PINOT NOIR 2012**

**\$45 per bottle**

Plusher with a bigger frame of both red and blue fruits, it is immediately seductive. The palate is richer again with plum, dark spiced cherry fruit that drives through to a complex, yet fresh finish. The earthy, autumnal aftertaste bodes well for the future.



### **CHATEAU LES PAGODES DES COS 2009, BORDEAUX - SAINT ESTEPHE, FRANCE**

**\$139 per bottle**

The full-bodied, round, generous Les Pagodes de Cos exhibits lots of creme de cassis and floral notes intermixed with hints of wood/baroque and spice. Juicy, succulent and remarkably fresh and well-delineated, spices, nutmeg, dark fruits on the nose, follow through to a full body, with very precise tannins and a long finish. A beautiful racy wine.



### **COLLEONI ROSSO DI MONTALCINO 2011, TUSCANY, ITALY**

**\$59 per bottle**

A maniacal approach to farming based on sustainable practices has led Colleoni to focus on restoring a healthy, vibrant ecosystem in his vineyards in the Montosoli zone. The wines are made with indigenous yeasts and aged in cask. Colleoni releases 8,000 to 9,000 bottles in total, of which 3,000 are Brunello and 2,500 are Rosso from Brunello-designated vineyards.



### **BAROLO CERETTO 'ZONCHERO' 2007**

**\$72 per bottle**

This is a soft, harmonious, velvety Barolo, with limited tannin content and a fine balance between alcohol and acid. It displays extraordinary drinkability after just a few months in the bottle and can be enjoyed for at least 10 years.



### **ESK RESERVE SYRAH 2006, NEW ZEALAND**

**\$69 per bottle**

This is a very varietal wine, displaying classic Gimblett Gravels Syrah notes of plums, blackberries, pepper and exotic spice notes. It is a rich and full bodied style with excellent natural acidity.
