



PARENT/TEENAGER - TRY CLAY TARGET SHOOTING

WHEN

Friday 8 or Saturday 9 July 2022

Bookings are essential - please do not attend without having registered.

THE EVENT

This will be an introduction to firearm safety and shooting moving clay targets with a 12 gauge under/over shotgun. The event will feature a diverse assortment of targets catered to the abilities of the participants. The event is designed to entertain novice shooters while they learn more about the sport of clay target shooting. The event is scheduled during the school holidays to provide a sporting activity for a parent and a teenager. No unaccompanied teenagers are permitted. There will be an emphasis on safety and as well as having an enjoyable activity.

COST

\$80 per person billed to your Club account. Cancellations less than 3 days before the event may not receive a refund. The gun club will provide shotguns, ammunition and ear protection. Do not bring your own shotgun. Please bring your own morning tea.

ELIGIBILITY AND DRESS

This activity is suitable for both first-time shooters and experienced shooters.

You must bring photo identification such as a driver licence. The minimum legal age to participate is 11 years. Shotguns are a reasonably heavy firearm to hold and there is recoil to both the shoulder and cheekbone. It is suggested that a minimum age be around 15 years and that participants have the physical strength and be robust enough for the recoil.

If a person is not legally allowed to attend a range or be in possession of a firearm then they are not to attend this event (see below.)

The event will be held outdoors so suitable clothing, a short or long-sleeved shirt (no tank-tops), sunglasses, sunscreen, a hat and closed shoes should be worn. No camouflage clothing to be worn. Safety glasses will be supplied to those without prescription glasses or sunglasses. No drinking of alcohol before or during the event. If anyone is unwell or showing cold, flu or fever symptoms then please do not attend this event.

PERSONS NOT PERMITTED TO ATTEND

Persons who are not permitted to fire on a range or possess a firearm include persons:

- convicted of various crimes
- subject to a domestic violence order
- subject to orders under the Mental Health Act.

They would be aware of what they are legally allowed and not allowed to do.
